

LESSON PLAN EXAMPLE

Lesson Objective (s): 1. Students will work in cooperative learning groups.
2. Students will research information on facts about HIV/AIDS and how to prevent the disease.

Activity: *(This will take 2-3 days to complete.)*

1. Two students in the group will research facts and prevention of HIV/AIDS on the Internet.
2. One student will begin to work on the artwork for the brochure.
3. One student will begin to work on the Power Point presentation.

Evaluation: 1. Students will be evaluated at the end of the unit on the brochure they prepare.
2. Students will be evaluated at the end of the unit on their Power Point presentation.

Extension/Modification: Students who are having a difficult time locating sites on the Internet will be given a hard copy of the web site information.

Cooperative Learning Ideas: Students will work on their assigned task in their cooperative learning group.
