Thematic Units using WebQuests

Enhance your thematic units using Web Quests. This presentation will discuss what WebQuests are and how they can be used to lead to higher order thinking skills. It will show you how to construct them as well as give you many Web sites where constructed WebQuests can be found.

Some Simple Steps to Follow:

- ✓ Start with your curriculum.
- ✓ Focus on alignment of TEKS/Student Expectations and your curriculum.
- ✓ Identify a Knowledge and Skill statement for your Web Unit topic.
- ✓ Write an introduction to provide background information on the topic.
- ✓ Create tasks for learners to accomplish.
- ✓ Search for resources to help students complete tasks.
- ✓ List all resources on the Web Unit topic.
- ✓ Describe clearly defined steps to complete the WebQuest projects.
- ✓ Design an assessment to measure the results. Did the learners accomplish the task? What is the quality of the presentation?
- ✓ Write a conclusion that brings closure to the WebQuests and encourages the learner to extend the experience.
