Mitchell B. Nesenoff, Ph.D.

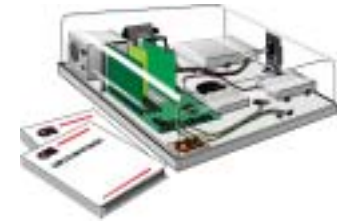
