Dreamweaver Training

Learn about the concepts and tools required for website development using Dreamweaver.

The focus of this workshop will be on the design and implementation of Dreamweaver into actual applications to be used in the classroom. Topics to be presented include planning content and navigation of a web site, creating and modifying web pages, formatting information for web pages, creating and modifying graphics for web pages, resolving problems, developing final pages, and publishing web pages.
